May

- [Select](#) fine arts courses (7th and 8th graders)
- [Schedule](#) placement testing (all new students)
- If required, schedule a Student Learning Plan meeting with Learning Specialist [Carleigh Knight](#)

June

- Attend placement testing and the New and Used Uniform Sale: June 1, June 2, or June 4
- [Schedule](#) a course selection meeting (Upper School only)
- Begin familiarizing yourself with [Blackbaud](#), our parent and student portal, after receiving full access
- Review summer work requirements with your child and create a plan to complete the required work

July

- Submit your student's final transcript for the 2021-22 school year to registrar@atlantagirlsschool.org
- Print, fill, and submit all required medical forms, which may be dropped off on campus or scanned and emailed to nurse@atlantagirlsschool.org
- Read the *AGS Summer Update* email, which will contain important back-to-school information for all new and returning families

August

- Attend the Used Uniform Sale August 8
- Attend orientation for all new parents and students on August 9
- Set up an account with [Campus Cuisine](#) if you are interested in utilizing lunch delivery service at additional cost

Ongoing

- Review the [bring-your-own-device specifications](#) before purchasing a computer for your child
- Review your child's textbook and supply requirements and purchase necessary items
- Shop online for uniforms and spirit wear at Land's End
