

Uniform and Dress Code:

The AGS preferred provider for uniforms for the 2023-2024 school year is Land's End.

- All tops should be purchased from this vendor and should include the AGS logo.
- Bottoms can be purchased from Land's End and other retailers as long as they are the same style/pattern/color.

General Uniform and Appearance Guidelines:

- Students should be in uniform from the time they arrive on campus until school is dismissed.
- All clothing and shoes should be clean, neat, and in good repair.
- Skirts, skorts, and shorts should be no shorter than the top of the knee both in front and in back.
- Non AGS coats should NOT be worn in class or during indoor school activities.
- AGS Team and club sweatshirts or AGS jackets may be worn any time except on formal uniform days. All sweatshirts and jackets must be approved by the Uniform Committee.
- If a student is not in uniform, she will be asked to correct the situation.
 Repeat violations will be handled by the divisional Deans, and/or US Director.

Formal Uniform:

Unless otherwise noted, AGS will have a formal uniform day on Monday of each week for All-School Assembly.

Non-Uniform Dress:

Non-uniform days are announced in advance. Students should be covered from shoulders to mid-thigh with no visible undergarments. High heels, flip-flops, or any backless shoes are not permitted. Crop tops, midriff-baring, or "belly" shirts are not permitted.

Physical Education Uniform:

- The PE uniform consists of any AGS athletic t-shirt. It may be an AGS team shirt, Earth/Sky shirt, or any other shirt purchased at the AGS Spirit Store. AGS polos are not permitted.
- The PE shorts may be any navy or black short with a minimum inseam
 of 4". Navy/black tights or leggings as well as solid or AGS
 navy/black/gray sweatpants are accepted in cooler weather.
 ***Sweatpants may not be worn with uniform skirt.
- SHOES: Athletic Shoes MUST be worn for all P.E. Classes (Converse, Vans, Keds and other non-supportive footwear are NOT considered athletic footwear.)

Polo (Knit Shirt)	Navy, White, Light Blue or Pale Yellow Polo Shirt with AGS logo (short or long sleeved) **Polos may be worn on formal dress days but not worn to PE**
Sweater	 Navy V-Neck Pullover or Sweater Vest with AGS logo Navy Button-Down Cardigan with AGS logo **Must be worn over an AGS shirt**
Sweatshirt	Navy Crewneck or Hoodie with current AGS logo **May not be worn on formal dress days and must be worn over an AGS shirt**
Blazer	Optional Navy Blazer with AGS logo
Fleece/ Jacket	Navy fleece with AGS embroidered logo Navy nylon jacket with AGS embroidered logo
Socks/Tights /Privacy Shorts	 Socks and tights are optional but should not be distracting to the learning community. Crew, ankle or knee socks, ANY color White, black or navy tights White, black or navy leggings with socks Shorts required under skirts unless tights or leggings are worn ***Sweatpants may not be worn with uniform skirt.
Shoes	Shoes of your choice, must have a back. NO slippers, NO Crocs
